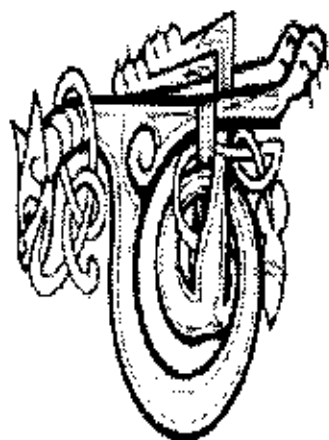
Well that's it for this month. See you at the coronet tourney.

The arms of the Palatine Barony of the Far West are: Gules, a dolphin embowed argent naiant through a laurel wreath Or, all between three water bougets argent.

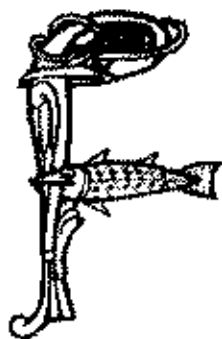

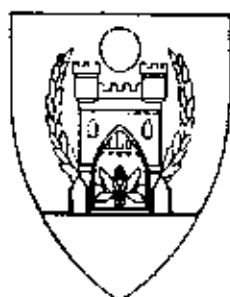

Coronet Arts & Science Tourney



The Stronghold of Warriors Gate has been awarded the privilege of hosting this April's Coronet Tourney. We are planning a camping event in Pusan with THL Charmaine de Chanson as autocrat and Lady Aodhnait as feastocrat. (Unless you have something special that you sleep on everything will be provided except sheets for bedding and towels for showers.)

Site opens Friday at 1700 on the 3rd of April. Dinner will be served all evening. (I hear it will be one of Lady Aodhnait's famous stews so bring a healthy appetite -- actually Lady Aodhnait is doing all the cooking so starve yourself the week before.)
