New Bedrock Lobby Update

On October 31st, Bedrock received a fresh new hub for Halloween, returning to its roots with a medieval-themed build. Being much larger than the past lobbies, there are many diverse areas to explore, ranging from a formidable fortress to a vibrant, expansive cave system complete with waterfalls and a parkour course!

As many veteran players will know, Mineplex began life on Bedrock with a medieval-themed lobby in 2016, a trend that continued until the addition of the modern city hub in 2020. Following two years with this hub, the lobby has once again transitioned back to the

iconic medieval theme of the past, filling long-time players with nostalgia while offering new players a taste of the past.

In this article, we've decided to interview various players throughout the Bedrock community to gather their feedback on the new hub!

What are your thoughts on the new Bedrock hub?

WidestSinger982: "I really love the new lobby, it's big and is similar to the old castle lobby while still being new! My favorite part would have to be the underground parkour because it's a lot longer and harder than the last. When I first saw the hub I was shocked at how big it was and how much space you have to explore!"

The Arrows Shadow: "I was very excited when it first came out, I was one of the first people to actually see the lobby because I was not sleeping when it went out around 3-4 AM. It's very hype to see the work of the build team, and it's always just amazing to see Bedrock get an update at all. The builders did not disappoint, going back to the medieval theme and increasing the size of the hub were fantastic improvements from the old lobby. I was never a huge fan of the modernized city hub, so when I stepped into the new lobby for the first time my mind was absolutely blown by the amount of detail and the sheer size of the hub. There were a ton of new things to explore, and very exciting to see Bedrock get some much-needed attention!"

I was predominantly playing Mineplex during that time period so it just feels like home. Although, I do wish that it had come out only when the original lobby was also finished, but I understand that development on all the features it'll have seems to be taking a while.
