If you have logged into Mineplex recently, you might have noticed that some things have changed. Notably, our lobby has receive a huge revamp. It's been decluttered and reorganized to make it easier to find the games you want to play. This Discord server is used to communicate various updates on our Java and Bedrock networks and will serve as an alternative hub for discussing community ideas and feedback. When you first join the server, you'll be asked to read and agree to the rules in #read-me. From there, you are free to explore and chat as you please.

# **EVENTS TEAMS!**

Mineplex hosts a large variety of events weekly that are run by the Events Squad, a Senior Mod team, along with people on Events Assistance, a sub-team that is open to both staff and community members. We got to step behind the scenes and talk to Harvvey, a community member on EA, and Bunni, a Sr.Mod and the EA lead, about their work.

### Why did you join EA?

Harvyey: Events have always appealed to me. I love the atmosphere and the interaction with the community in different ways, whether that's through event maps or mini-games with a spin on them. I used to join events back in late 2016, and see the hosts and think, that looks fun, and so I set my sights on EA. I was lucky enough to be on Community Assistance, when the team was still around, as we had the opportunity to join Events directly in early 2017, and I'm glad I did!

Bunni: I joined the events team originally when it was called server management because it appealed to me, the idea of doing events for the community looked fun. Back then it wasn't the same team as it is now but it was still awesome to be apart of and see the whole team transform throughout the years.

What does your work on your team consist of? Harvvey: The 'work' on the team is usually quite consistent. Our main role is to help co-host the weekly events we plan. We try to host around 2 US & EU events a week, but this can vary. We also comment and review event suggestions submitted by the community. Mineplex staff members on EA also have the opportunity to access the build server to create new event maps for our community events. These are events that are different to the weekly ones, and use an event map for the entire duration of the hosted event. The '12 Days of Christmas' event period last December is a brilliant example of this. Other than that, the event hosting is the main area of our work!

Bunni: On the events team, we have weekly events as well as the opportunity to build and create our own events. As a manager you have to make sure to the best of your ability that both are being worked on. Weekly events need to be set and hosted, prizes needed to be logged, monitoring ect. I also have to help come up with a new schedule and add it each season, as well as making sure everyone's behaving and doing what they're supposed to in events. Calling people bad is also common too though, but you know. We've got a lot of love here on events squad (:

Do you have a favorite memory from an event? Harvvey: I have too many - there are memories from every event we host that stay with me! My favourite would have to be the screenshot that we take at the end of the event. It just shows how many people turn up and love the events that we host for the community every week, and looking back on them really does make the role of EA feel very special. I've collected over 80+ of these screenshots so far, that's 80+ events attended, and each one has different memories and moments that were brilliant.

Bunni: I remember a long time ago, in a galaxy far away.. nah, just your normal Teamspeak lobby. We decided to host a St. Patrick's Day event and for whatever reason advertise it globally with the announcement. Well it was cool and all until the event server ended up crashing from all the players trying to join at the same time and we couldn't really host anything. Besides that, at the time, we were in Teamspeak with a bunch of staff and community members. To me it was this awesome blend of community and staff all chatting and having fun together, and it was the moment I want to try to create in every event to come, minus crashing the server.
