Mineplex Pocket Edition has been doing extremely well since launch, with thousands of players online every day! And along with it, some pretty awesome updates and new features have been released, including a brand new gamemode and rank! Here are some short summaries of the recent updates.

Dating back to October 8, the day Mob Arena was released: This was something players only occasionally experienced in Mineplex events before, but as of recent, it became an official game of the Pocket Edition server! In this gamemode, players must work together to stop the constant waves of monsters summoned into the arena. The mobs drop tokens, which can be exchanged for better equipment in the center of the map. The survivors at the end of all the rounds are pronounced winners!

Next, we had the release of crates! These three loot-filled trunks are very similar to the PC server's Treasure Chests. The most common chest is the Noble Crate. In this crate, you can open four boxes, each containing cheap cosmetics and occasionally some rare goodies. In Royal Crates, you also are able to open four chests, but with the chance of acquiring a legendary item. And finally, in Imperial Crates, you can only open one chest, but you are guaranteed a rare or legendary cosmetic that you don't already possess!

Following crates was the implementation of Bomb Lobbers! This game functions exactly like the PC Bomb Lobbers, albeit with some small adjustments to make it a little more PE friendly.

And finally, on the 15th of November was the lobby update! Carl and his friends finally made the journey to Mineplex Pocket Edition, and have taken their usual stance in the lobby. Upon clicking/tapping them, you are able to claim daily and monthly rewards! Additionally, a brand new lobby was released resembling a castle!


