MAP TESTING OVERVIEW! BY: SPOILER

Are you interested in having the privilege of playing exclusive upcoming Mineplex maps? The Map Tester team is available and open to all who are interested, with no set closing deadline! Aimed at those who believe they have experience in testing and experimenting with maps in progress, this team is designed to be an easy route for feedback regarding maps directly from the players.

Map Testers are advised to attend weekly meetings every Saturday at around 12PM PST. A Discord account is also required to join the team, however talking is not required. As the team is very casual and does not have strict quotas, it is highly recommended for those who want to contribute more to Mineplex, but don't want to feel the pressure of meeting strict deadlines or quotas.

Before applying, it is suggested that you take a look at the Map Submissions Guide to make sure you have a general understanding on what map testers must evaluate for each map. All games per map are separated into four different categories, those being "Casual," "Intermediate," "Hardcore," as well as "MPS Specific." In the map submissions process, map testers are directly involved with what is known as "Stage 2" of submitting a map, which involves a map's review and testing. During this stage, map testers examine maps for issues, gameplay discrepancies, and anything else that does not satisfy a map's criteria.

FEEDBACK TEAM OVERVIEW! BY: XUMBREON

The Feedback Team is a Community Management subteam on Mineplex and, as suggested by the name, their main job is to collect server feedback from the community. This team is vital for getting your voices heard: they manage our Feature Upvote system (https://mineplex.featureupvote.com) and make sure that as many ideas as possible are reviewed.

If you didn't know, Feature Upvote, which is run by the Feedback Team, is a website entirely made for players to post their ideas. You can choose to either scroll through suggestions made by other players or you can suggest an idea of your own. To post an idea, all you need to do is click the orange "add your suggestion" button on the top right, and follow the directions there. Once you finish, you can post your suggestion and receive feedback from others! Feedback constantly runs through Feature Upvote to find ideas to forward to upper management.

When a new update comes out, the Feedback Team immediately gets to work and collects as much feedback from the community on said update. They often go to the Mineplex Discord (discord.mineplex.com) for any update suggestions; however, you might also see them hanging around the forums or going in-game to look for feedback.

Feedback is an awesome team overall, and their duties are extremely important for the overall improvement of Mineplex. The team is run by EmmaLie, so if you have any general questions about the team, feel free to ask her or any other Feedback team member!



MARKETPLACE TEAM INTERVIEW! BY: FLAWSOME

The Minecraft Marketplace is an in-game store which can be found exclusively in the Bedrock Edition of the game. Using Minecoins, players are able to purchase from a variety of content, ranging from skin packs to custom adventure maps. The Marketplace is a platform where the community members can showcase their talent and share it to others, while also receiving compensation for their masterpieces!

Through its affiliation with Microsoft, Mineplex offers its own services and products on the Marketplace and even has a dedicated team, led by BlueBeetleHD, DeanTM, and Giovani. This team is focused on producing content for the community to enjoy! We sat down with Crumplex to hear more about what it's like to be a part of this team and how her experience has been thus far.

When did you join the team? What is your role on it?

I make skin packs for the Marketplace team. I've been making skin packs for Mineplex and the marketplace since before we had a team for it! My first skin pack was Mineplex Hero's. You may have seen my older works on our Java server, in the Mineplex Mavericks lobby, and Hero's of Gwen. The team was introduced as a builder subteam for map makers last year, but I also joined since I provided content for the marketplace too.

As an artist, where do you take inspiration from?

We have a bunch of theme ideas to choose from, but can also come up with our own. If the community has any suggestions we could do those too! Once we have a theme chosen we can be as creative as we want. I really enjoy making skins that involve animals or other creatures. Sometimes I will take inspiration from things in real life, for example, my dog in the Pets Life skin pack. It's a fun challenge to try and turn something realistic into a Minecraft skin.

Do you consider the team a demanding and stressful environment?

Not at all, it's very relaxed and we have lots of time to work on things. As an artist, having time to brainstorm and collect thoughts is important for making great content.

I have lots of free time after work and school to make skins. I usually make one every couple of days. I've had no problem finishing one skin pack every month! It's actually quite relaxing to make them, so I enjoy doing it.

How has your experience been on the team?

It's been great. Everyone's very supportive and nice and it's awesome to see your own content in an official Minecraft store!

A DAY IN THE LIFE! BY: ENUNCIATED

Staff members can be found all around the network. Some work on specialized sub-teams, while others work on everyday moderation tasks. Regardless, there's a lot that goes into a staff member's day. The newsletter team had the privilege to ask a Trainee, a Moderator, and a Sr.Mod about their daily operations here at Mineplex. Below, you can find descriptions of the day-to-day work of SkarmMines, Arjun, and TeaSpiller, respectively.

SkarmMines (Trainee): Typically, on my average day, I will get online and spend an hour or two to playing games with my friends, most likely being Cake Wars or Nano. Afterwards, I like to dedicate most of my time online on Staff Request. It's personally my favorite thing to do, being able to help or assist anyone that needs it. I'll probably spend more than two hours just focusing on Staff Request and making sure people's issues are being dealt with. Then, I like to go on the forums and interact a lot with users through threads, mostly in the off topic section or ideas hub. If I have any subteam work, for example on QAT or Translations Team, I also put time aside to work on what needs to be done for each subteam respectively.

Arjun (Moderator): Whether it be after a long school day or just a weekend, Mineplex holds a role in every single one of my days. I spend most of my time as a staff member dedicating time towards my two sub-teams, specifically Recruiter Assistance, or RA, and Reports Patrol. I usually chill in-game when doing these things. When I've done a bit of what I do as an RA, I check the reports section of the forums to see if I can respond to any forum reports. I also play games on the network on the daily. These games consist of Survival Games, Skywars, Super Smash Mobs, and occasionally DMT and NANO. I love interacting with people on the network, with both staff and community members, and occasionally hop in a Cake Wars party with some friends. All in all, my day on Mineplex is pretty fulfilling and holds a big part of my day!

TeaSpiller (Sr.Moderator): I'd say for me personally I have a schedule on my day-to-day activities so I don't overrun myself or forget important topics, this schedule covers mostly my Mineplex life since with in-real life topics I tend to just live with the flow. Anyways, when I start my Mineplex "duties" I tend to immediately look at the forums to see if there are any hot threads or just to take a glance at what's happening after I check the forums I log on and like to moderate lobbies for around 30-45 minutes before heading into Staff-1 which is where I do my sub-team work. With my sub-team work I check the bug threads to see if any have been sent in if there's not I move on to my assistant duties by processing Staff Reports or just looking over how our mentees are doing, after this I do reports for RP + comment on idea threads. After I work on those teams, I like to dedicate 1-2 hours to working on projects for the Mineplex Marketplace, but that pretty much sums up my regular day-to-day activities.
