Christmas Update Recap

As 2021 comes to a wrap, the Mineplex community enjoyed the sights and sounds of a magical Christmas season! Considered to be many peoples' favorite update of the year, this holiday season brought lots of cheer. From a brand new advent calendar, a reimagined winter hub, and even an overhaul to our headliner holiday game, Christmas Chaos, players all across Mineplex indulged in the festive fun!

On December 1st, players were greeted with a warm Christmas village-inspired Winter hub. Standing tall in the center is a magical clock tower, displaying the time for all to see. In this hub also stands the famous Mineplex Advent calendar where many players began their official holiday adventure. Furthermore, we saw the return of classic games such as Castle Siege and Snow Fight!

Roughly halfway into the month, the beloved holiday game, Christmas Chaos, made its triumphant return. This year's version featured new mini-bosses, new locations for power ups, and even brand new mazes and parkours!

To get more insight on the Christmas update this year, I decided to sit down with active community member OhCrazy to get a better insight about the update from the community's perspective.

What was your favorite part about Christmas Chaos this year?

OhCrazy: "My favorite part this year was changing the mob waves into two mini bosses. The waves from the previous years felt long and boring. I always enjoy fighting bosses in all types of games. Bringing back the golem tower into Christmas Chaos brings back memories from 2013 while the Jack Skeleton mini boss brings something fresh into the table with the new attack with the particle waves where you can dodge by jumping over the particles. I totally didn't squeal when I was getting shoved off a cliff by a group of snowmen."

What are your thoughts on the changes that occurred to CC this year? Was there anything that stood out to you while playing?

OhCrazy: "I really think the changes made this year made the game feel a lot more engaging. The renewed snake parkour and maze made them feel fresh. The new secret locations and the mini boss changes definitely stood out to me. This year's secret locations are a lot more well thought out with half of them requiring parkour to reach them. There are more penguins! I don't know how there are penguins in the north pole. Someone probably imported penguins into the north pole. The logic doesn't really matter because I love it. There are penguins chilling near cliffs, a family of penguins in the spike hole, one is lost in the maze, and one taunts you in the old secret location."

One of the spotlight festivities that occurs every holiday is our grand Christmas hub, made by our very own Build Team. This year's winter hub is filled with tons of snow, candy, presents, and more! Players have even discovered some Easter Eggs from their favorite holiday movies. Characters such as The Grinch, Olaf, Elsa, and even Mr. Tumnus are all featured in the lobby.

As players made their way around the hub, they even discovered our very own Present Hunt! We hid 30 presents around the hub this year and after completing it, players were gifted with an exclusive Hub title, an omega chest, and more!

I decided to talk with lan923, a Build Team member, to get some insight as to how he thought the hub turned out this year.

What is your favorite part of the Christmas Hub this year?

lan923: "My favorite part of the Christmas hub is definitely the spawn area — more specifically the clocktower and game portal houses, which were loosely based on those light-up ceramic models you often see in stores around Christmas time. Originally we considered a few ideas for the spawn structure, the runner-up being a snow globe, which we ultimately decided against due to it just not working for the type of spawn area we wanted. It was difficult getting rid of the large Christmas tree that typically sits over spawn, but the clocktower gave us a lot more freedom to experiment and I especially like the houses around it which compliment it really well."

What did you help work on for the hub this holiday season?

lan923: "I built most of the area around the spawn, including the clocktower, portal houses, and gladiator arena. I also did much of the lava parkour island, including the houses there which I had actually made a while ago for a MineKart map that was never finished. My other responsibilities included pasting some old assets from former Christmas hubs, like the Olaf organic and the Christmas tree near spawn."

What did you find most challenging while decorating the hub?

lan923: "The most difficult part for me was making the houses above and around the game portals. I had a bit of a hard time since I wanted them to all look different enough but also compliment one another as a singular structure. I ended up using a similar block palette for all three sections while altering some roof shapes and colors. I think this allowed the houses to look distinct but also coordinated at the same time."

Because this is the year that keeps on giving, I have prepared a behind-thescenes look at our process of the Holiday Hub this year. The Build Team is delighted to bring the Mineplex community beautiful seasonal overhauls to the server every year and with that being said, here are some screenshots of the process!

In the very beginning stages, the hub is all clear of old decor and the Build Team starts brainstorming what we could potentially have in the hub. This year, the process began with this very... adorable.. snowman.



But alas! The centerpiece of this year's hub was created first and we settled on a clock tower. It's fully decorated with garland, snow, ice, and more! This also serves as the centerpiece of our Christmas town theme we were going for this holiday season.




