

Bedrock Over the Years

Mineplex Bedrock Edition, or Pocket Edition as it was formerly known, was released to the world on July 4th 2016, featuring five games - Micro Battles, Skywars Solo and Teams, Turf Wars and Master Builders. Shortly after, the first purchasable Bedrock rank, Knight, was released and offered perks such as exclusive particle effects.

Across the following months, various key features were implemented such as achievements, levels, an anti cheat and even a companion app was made available for Google Play and iOS, which players could use to view leaderboards. Survival Games, Mob Arena and Bomb Lobbers were introduced to the server along with a fresh new hub.



During December, a Christmas-themed gamemode known as Merry Mayhem was released and would continue to make an appearance during the festive season in later years. Dragon Escape was also released on Bedrock.

2017 kicked off with the release of Mineplex Bedrock's second rank, Lord, followed by a number of popular game additions in Spring including Gladiators, Skyfall Solo and Teams, and Block Hunt.



Later on, Quiver made its first appearance on Bedrock as part of the Mixed Arcade NPC, though it was later given a separate NPC due to its immediate popularity. Survival Games was given a teams gamemode and Death Tag was added to the server. September saw the addition of Mineplex's most popular gamemode, Cake Wars, which continues to attract large amounts of players to this day. That same month, Mineplex Bedrock was opened up to Windows and Xbox players due to Minecraft's Better Together update, and with this came new ranks - Duke and Duchess, offering even more perks.



Nintendo Switch players could access Mineplex Bedrock from January 4th 2018, a year that saw the addition of Factions to the server. During the Summer, a new castle island hub was released, featuring in-game leaderboards, as well as the addition of Dragons and a huge Mob Arena rework. In September, Speed Builders was introduced to Bedrock, followed by Creative Housing and the first custom pet on Bedrock, the Corgi.



The year of 2019 began with a massive update to Cake Wars, featuring new items, holograms and QoL changes, alongside important updates to Creative Housing and the party system. 2020 saw the birth of the current city hub, in addition to the removal of various games including Skyfall, Factions and Survival Games while Turf Wars, Micro Battles and Dragons were merged into the Classics NPC.

Gyroninja joined the development team during August, and marked his introduction with a major Skywars update and several server-wide changes to knockback and the AFK timer. Castle Defense made its first appearance as Bedrock's new holiday game for Halloween, likewise with Snow Fight during the Winter Event. This update also included a holiday game rotation NPC, which rotated between various old and new minigames, ranging from Quiver to Cake Wars Solos.



2021 marked a milestone year for **Bedrock as Mineplex Bedrock Edition** turned 5 years old in July. In celebration of this, Bomb Lobbers returned to the server and was accompanied by a significant Cake Wars update. Cake Wars would later see even more love as it would be given a permanent Solos gamemode in October, alongside the return of Castle Defense. The holiday rotation again made an appearance in 2021, featuring a different set of games compared to the previous year. Finally, in 2022, an experimental Cake Wars gamemode was implemented in the form of Cake Wars Mega for 2 weeks, along with the invasion of giant chickens for April Fool's.

We hope you enjoyed exploring Mineplex Bedrock's history. We are excited to see what's in store for the future!
