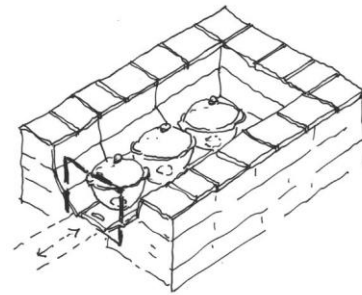
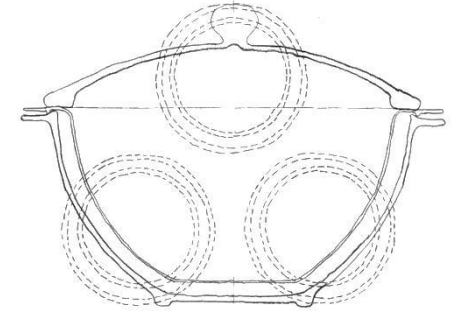
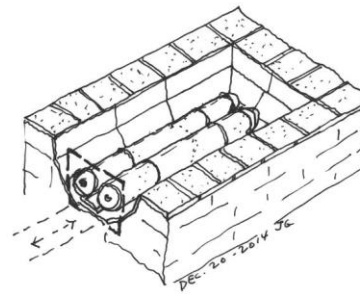




Thru-wall solar cooker door-form

Glazed cookware are considered for thru-wall cookers to unglazed nonimaging reflectors.

The HotPot TM oven made in Mexico with World Bank funding has two glass parts and a metal pot. These three parts weigh about 8.5 pounds/3.8 kg and when filled with water weigh 16 pounds/7.2 kg. Try lifting that walking outdoors to a reflector and back indoors with the cooked food. The HotPot TM weight increases chances for breakage to expensive glass parts with frequent carrying outdoors and is too heavy for some cooks.

Two or three 4"od x 1m all-glass evacuated tube cookers (GoSun TM, etc.) fits within the profile of a HotPot TM cooker. A restaurant kitchen may use both types of glazed cookers.
