

20191121 **Oriental**s with Bits of Caucasoid

Korean waitresses and cooks at the restaurant Gami Sushi say "like cold Turkey" and "not just Turkey" to obliquely refer to the bits of ancient Caucasoid in their ancestry, as many other Orientals, including Japanese, Chinese, Vietnamese, Mongolians, and Thais do, too.
